



Delivery rental boats

Terms and conditions

DEPOSIT

A deposit corresponding to the excess on insurance of SEK 10,000 is reserved on the payment card at the time of pickup. Deductible reduction can be added as an option, which lowers the deposit and deductible by 50% to SEK 5,000. The deposit is refunded in full when the boat is returned in undamaged condition. If there is any doubt in connection with the return, the deposit is held to check possible costs for damages, the remaining amount is refunded within 14 days.

CANCELLATION

Daily or weekly rental: In case of cancellation up to 72 hours/3 days before the agreed start of rental, a booking fee of 10% of the agreed boat rental is charged. In case of cancellation later than 72 hours/3 day hours before the agreed start of the rental, 100% of the agreed boat rental will be charged. If the optional "Rebooking guarantee" has been purchased, you can rebook the date free of charge up to 72 hours/3 days) before the agreed start.

Season rental: In case of cancellation up to 30 days before the agreed start of rental, a booking fee of 10% of the agreed boat rental is charged. In case of cancellation later than 30 days before the agreed start of the rental, 100% of the agreed boat rental is charged.

The booking fee is not charged if the cancellation is due to the lessee being prevented from traveling according to the authorities' regulations.

Lessor's responsibility

Delivery

The boat must be delivered at the agreed time. If the lessor is unable to deliver the boat on time due to circumstances beyond his control, for example a breakdown or late arrival of the previous lessee, the lessor must refund as much of the rent as corresponds to the delay. In the event of a delivery delay of more than 24 hours, the lessee has the right to cancel the agreement and get the full rental amount back. Claims for damages and costs cannot be invoked from the lessee.

Equipment

The lessor undertakes to hand over to the lessee the boat and its equipment according to the checklist in working order. The boat must be handed over with a full fuel tank. Only Alkylat gasoline should be refueled if available.

Insurance

The lessor is responsible for the boat being insured. The scope of the insurance, amount of liability and excess are determined by the conditions established by the lessor's insurance company.

In the event of damage or loss, the lessee is responsible for all costs up to the deposit. To the extent that damage or loss to the boat and accessories is not covered by the insurance or occurred due to unauthorized use, theft of an unlocked boat, negligence, non-seamanlike or statutory handling handling. In these cases the lessee is obliged to compensate the entire loss or damage.

Interruption

In the event of loss of time caused by damage to the boat and/or repairs for which the lessor is responsible, and which caused serious hindrance to the use of the boat for more than 24 hours after notification, the lessee shall be compensated proportionately for the time lost. Repair costs that may be incurred by the lessee due to defects in the boat are reimbursed after agreement with the lessor.

Lessees responsibility**Skipper's competence**

Lessees must have sufficient experience and competence to be able to drive the rented boat in a reassuring and seamanlike manner. The lessee certifies with his signature that he has the required competence and experience. The lessee is reminded of the responsibility for the boat and crew that rests with him in terms of seamanship and by law. Should it appear during the rental period that the lessee does not handle the boat in a seamanlike and legally prescribed manner, or that the boat is handled carelessly and otherwise neglected, the lessor has the right to cancel the rental. The remaining rental amount is thereby forfeited.

Boat maintenance, use and damage costs

The Lessee undertakes to read and approve the damage documentation assigned by the Lessor before the boat is put into use. The lessee undertakes to take care of the boat with associated equipment and follow the instructions and directions given by the lessor. The renter bears the responsibility that the boat is not damaged or lost during the rental period. The lessee further undertakes to use the boat only for pleasure. The boat may not be used in competition, towing, transport of goods or transport of passengers against payment (Prohibition against towing does not apply in emergency situations.) The renter is responsible for following the applicable laws and regulations during the rental period. The renter undertakes not to re-rent or transfer the boat to another.

If the boat is returned abnormally dirty, a cleaning fee of SEK 1,280 is added.

If the boat is returned with an empty tank, a tank fee of SEK 350 plus fuel is added.

In the event of damage caused by the Lessor's approved use and conditions, the Lessee must pay all costs up to the excess, the amount of which is stated under "Deposit and Excess". Costs are listed in table 1.1 below:

Cost for damage or loss of equipment is for new.

The lessee can, for a special fee, sign a so-called deductible, the size of which is stated under "Deposit and deductible" and thus reduce his liability for damages in the event of damage caused by the Lessor's approved use and conditions.

In case of damage or total loss caused by use not approved by the Lessor, theft of an unlocked boat, negligence, non-seamanlike or statutory handling, both in respect of performance and mooring/storage, damage costs corresponding to the Lessor's full cost of restoring the damage or replacing the boat in the event of a total loss are paid.

Use of the boat

The boat may only be driven within Swedish territorial waters. Should the lessee not respect the above limitations in the right of use, the lessor has the right to terminate the lease as soon as such a situation becomes known. The remaining rent as well as the disposition paid is thereby forfeited. In addition, the lessee must reimburse the boat owner for all costs associated with returning the boat to Dyvik.

Return

After the rental period, the boat is left in Dyvik at the agreed time. If the lessee should be prevented from returning the boat at the agreed time, he must notify the lessor of the delay without delay. In the case of delayed return, the renter is charged a compensation equivalent to double the contracted rent calculated proportionally for any loss inflicted on the lessor by the fact that the boat could not be made available to the next renter.

Actions in case of error, damage or loss

If during the rental period there is a fault with the boat or equipment, a breakdown, fire or theft of the boat or loose equipment, Sjöassistans must be notified immediately by phone on 020-98 90 00 and their instructions for action followed. The lessor must also be notified directly by phone 08-54354300. The lessee has the right to recover from the lessor the costs he incurred for the repair of such errors and deficiencies for which the Lessor is responsible. However, the Lessee must first obtain the Lessor's express and written permission to carry out the repair and approval of the amount of the cost. Reimbursement is only issued upon presentation of a receipt. In cases where the Lessor or his representative could not be reached for a period exceeding 72 hours after the occurrence of the damage and a repair for which the Lessor is responsible is necessary for the continued use of the boat, the Lessee is, however, free to have such a repair carried out at the lessor's expense. Lost equipment is replaced and charged according to the catalog price list.

In the event of damage, a new deposit for excess must be paid if the lessee wishes to continue the rental. If an equivalent boat cannot be offered, the Lessor has the right to offer another model. However, the lessor has the right to refuse continued rental and the rent paid for the entire period is then non-refundable.

Dispute

Disputes relating to the interpretation or application of these terms and conditions must first be resolved by voluntary agreement. If the parties cannot agree, the dispute must be settled in a district court according to Swedish law.
